The PRDP is a six-year (2013-2018) initiative of the government envisioned to increase farm and fishery productivity and incomes in target areas in all 16 regions of the country. The programse ekstoachieve this objective by improving access of farmers and other industry players to a strategic network of infrastructure, market information and support services.
