WHEREAS, Section 3.5 , Paragraph III of the Guidelines on Procurement of Goods, Works and Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grans by World Bank Borrowers provides:

Shopping

3.5 Shopping is a procurement method based on comparing price quotations obtained from several suppliers (in the case of goods), from several contractors (in the case of civil works), or service providers (in the case of non-consulting services) with a minimum of three, to assure competitive prices, and is an appropriate method for procuring limited quantities of readily available off-the-shelf goods or standard specification commodities of small value, or simple civil works of small value⁶⁴ when more competitive methods are not justified on the basis of cost and efficiency.

WHEREAS, four (4) sealed quotations for the requirement were received prior to the deadline and were opened on 30 September 2015, details of which are shown in the attached Abstract of Bids labelled hereto as Annex "A";

WHEREAS, all proposals received were referred to the Technical Working Group, whose evaluation was received by the SBAC Secretariat on 01 October 2015;

WHEREAS, highlights of the evaluation submitted by the TWG are detailed as follows:

1. Four sealed proposals were received from different suppliers, namely: **Link Network Solutions Inc., Remax International Inc., Bayan PC Technologies and Columbia Technologies Inc;**
2. All four (4) of the bidders complied with requirements stated in the RFQ;
3. Based on the documents submitted, **LINK NETWORK SOLUTIONS INC.** is the Lowest Complying and Responsive Bidder.

WHEREAS, after a careful review of the evaluation undertaken by the Technical Working Group, the Committee finds the said evaluation in order and resolved to adopt its findings;
